A highlight for many children was to be able to make sushi.

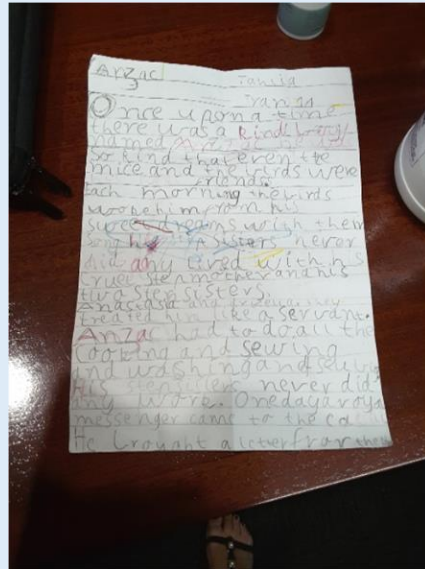


## Fairy-tale writing -Year 1

**What is an ecosystem? How do living things survive or thrive?**

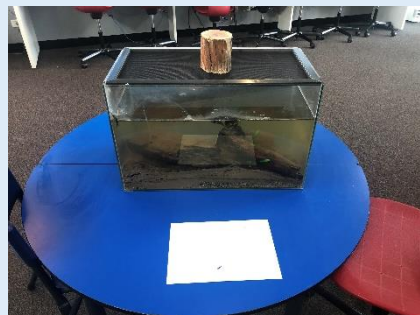
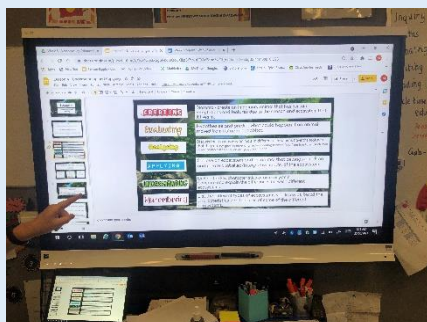
Some question responses from students
