The Grade 5-6's made these awesome snowglobes for their Mum or special carer.

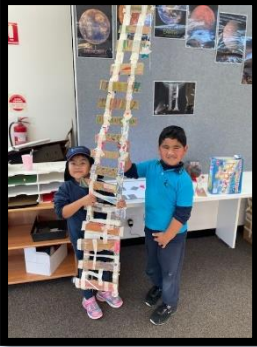
Each child created a scene or character from special plasticine and then attached it to the lid of the jar before filling it with glitter and water.
