Here is some of their learnings



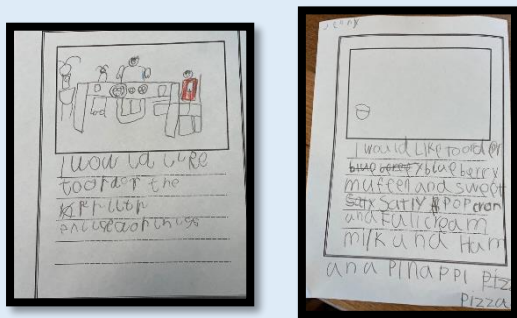
At each step of their research, they have focused on what they have been curious about and developed their learning alongside their teachers.
