KPS School Council met via Webex on Monday May 23<sup>rd</sup>.

Our student leaders started a presentation about our reconciliation Plan at KPS. They will continue this presentation at the next meeting.

KPS School Council was pleased to welcome two new school council members Mrs. Johanette Fraser and Ms. Alicia Morris.

The School Council this week ratified number of policies and documents including the new Child Safe Standards. They also had opportunities to review other new documentation for Child Safe Standards that are formally in place from July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2022.

This week I was also able to meet with our student school leaders and the wellbeing student leaders to look at the Code of Conduct and aspects of the Child Safe Standards Risk management document.



Our Child Safety Code of Conduct sets the boundaries and expectations for appropriate behaviours between adults and students.

It also clarifies behaviours that are not acceptable in our physical and online environments.

We ensure that students also know what is acceptable and what is not acceptable so that they can be clear and confident about what to expect from adults in the school.

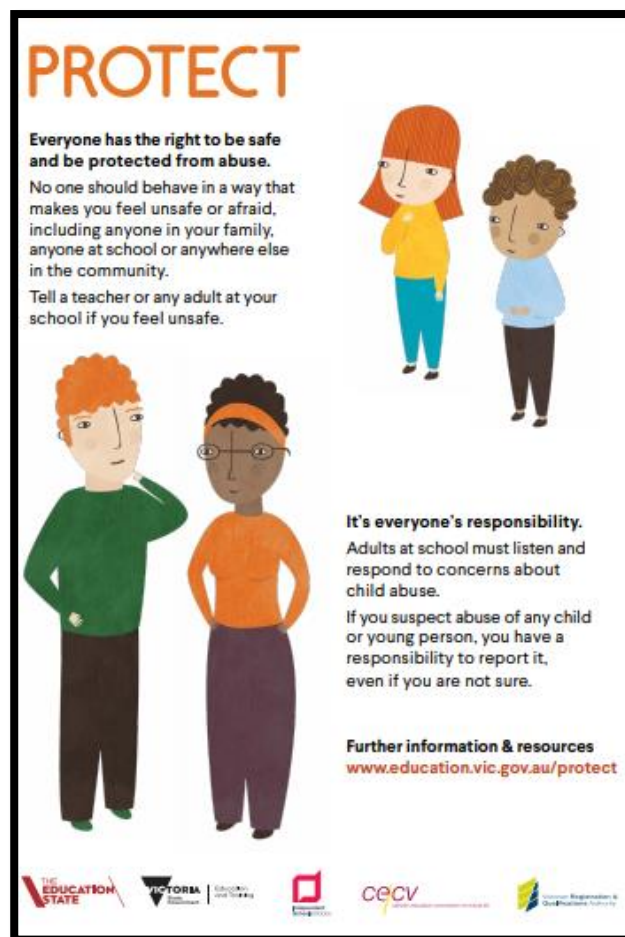
We had met a few weeks ago, where read and discussed the KPS Child Safety and Wellbeing Policy.

## District Cross Country

Last week, on Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> May, thirty -six athletes representing Keysborough Primary School represented the school in the Noble Park District Cross Country event. It was held at Wachter Reserve (Keysborough) with twelve government and independent schools competing.

The weather was perfect for running cross country. The athletes ranged in age from nine years to thirteen and from Years 3 to 6. The distances were 2 kilometers for 9/10-year-olds and 3 kilometers for eleven and twelve year olds.



The school came 7<sup>th</sup> overall with four athletes finishing in the top ten of their respective gage groups and going on to compete at Division on Friday.

They are Gabrielle T (11yo) second place, Max M (9/10 yr) second place, Ahmed T (12 yr)7<sup>th</sup> place and Shya S (11yr) a commendable 9<sup>th</sup> place.
